#### The following rules apply at all times:

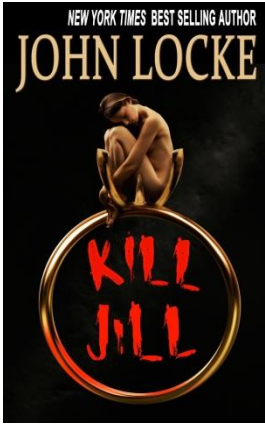
- Please keep this area neat and tidy. Food should not be consumed in the Activities Studio.

## Medication Notice

As an Academy we have a duty of care to make sure medication is administered safely to pupils. We have a strict policy that we are unable to give medication orally or externally unless permission has been given by the parent in writing for a prescribed medicine. Pupil Services need to be informed of any medication brought into the Academy. The Academy can only accept medicines that have been prescribed and that are in their original container as dispensed by a pharmacist and full instructions will need to be made clear, so that we can administer medication effectively.

The Academy cannot allow the self-administration of Ibuprofen, Aspirin or Paracetamol during the Academy day. If a Pupil is diagnosed with a medical problem and requires treatment please inform the Academy as soon as possible so we can ensure that your child gets the appropriate care and support that they need.
