## LEARNING FOR THE 21ST CENTURY

Sarum Academy provides a wide range of A Level & BTEC courses for individualised learning pathways which can be chosen in a variety of combinations to meet individual needs and aspirations.

It's important to us that pupils are following a curriculum that is right for them. Traditional A Level courses in the sciences, arts and humanities support progression to university whilst vocational opportunities such as Health and Social Care, catering, mechanics and hairdressing can lead to chosen careers and employment. Universities usually require at least 3 A Level and / or 3 A Level equivalent qualifications as a standard entry requirement for degree courses.

Unique to Salisbury, we also have an elite pathway for talented sports players to access coaching and team selection through partnerships with local professional and amateur clubs.
